This month the topics covered include ram management – maintaining the health and condition of rams in readiness for the tugging season, lead poisoning in cattle and contagious pustular dermatitis (Orf) in sheep. In this webinar James Aitken BSc BVetMed MRCVS, Orchard Veterinary Group, Glastonbury, discusses the presenting signs, treatment and prevention of these conditions.

Parasite Forecast

NADIS publishes a monthly Parasite Forecast for farmers and livestock keepers, based on detailed Met office data. The Parasite Forecast outlines the parasitic challenge facing cattle and sheep in the different regions of the UK. Again this month the main focus is on ***Nematodirus*** infection, the risk of which is expected to be **very high** this June with cases of Nematodirosis probably even running into July. Also covered are PGE and liver fluke in cattle and sheep, cattle lungworm (husk) and myiasis (blowfly) in sheep.
